Notice the significant dispensational (discontinuance) differences in Paul. During Acts

Chart 1. Paul wrote letters speaking of redemption thru His blood & justification BUT the hope was earthly of the Feasts, see Gals.3 and Roms.15:4-13 1Cor.15, 1Thess.4. The believing Jews and Gentiles a remnant of prophecy; the seed of Abraham, a chaste virgin, Christ the Bridegroom.

After Acts

Chart 2. Only after Israel was set aside at Acts 28:25-28 was Paul given the present set of conditions, the dispensation of the grace of God with its heavenly hope. The Feasts' salvation was postponed, placed aside, we live in a parenthetical dispensation. We are Christ's body, He the head.

Chart 1

The salvation of God continues for all people on the earth. There is no heavenly hope at this time. Also in effect the Gospels, the general epistles and Revelation.

> The return of the Lord was imminent as God held out His hands to Israel.



Chart 2

The salvation of God for the world Is postponed at Acts 28 when Israel was put aside. A new dispensation given to Paul.

The imminent return of the Lord was put aside. We are not waiting for the Trumpets coming to earth of the Lord but His appearing in the heavenly places.
