-SUFFERING AND GLORY-

The first time the Lord spoke of His sufferings was in Matt. 16:21. He spoke of how He would suffer many things of the elders, priests, In prophecy there is no distinc- and scribes, be killed, and be raised again the third day. But in verse 27 He speaks of when He shall come in the glory of His Father.

> When He talked with the two dis-ENTER INTO HIS GLORY?

In Acts 3, Peter preached that from that time on the Lord could come again at any moment; that He had fulfilled the prophecies concerning sufferings and that the only thing needed to bring on the glory was the repentance of Israel. That is still true yet today. The Lord's coming is dependent upon the repentance of Israel. He cannot come until Israel is ready to take their part in the New Covenant. The New Covenant had been made for THE REMISSION OF SINS. So Peter said, REPENT YE THEREFORE, THAT YOUR SINS MAY BE BLOTTED OUT.

Acts was the period in which the OTHER SERVANTS of Matt. 22:4 were sent out with the invitation. All things were ready. All that was SHOULD FOLLOW (1 Pet. 1:11) and the SO GREAT SALVATION (1 Pet. 1:5).

But the rejection of Israel has postponed the GLORY nearly 2,000 years. In the meantime God has been working out another purpose with its own peculiar dispensation.

To share in His glory, we must first suffer. This is a truth for all times.

-FORGIVENESS-

Death is not the result of sins. An UNTIMELY death can be caused by sins. It may either be by the ruin of health by sins against the body, or it can be an untimely death exocuted by a state which has been outraged by one's sins.

Death comes upon all because of Adam's sin. By one man sin care into the world, and by sin came this death. Adam had the choice of life or death for the whole race. He chose death for the whole race. If it were not for the fact that

God, in His wonderful mercy, had provided us another life in His Son, the whole human race would be without hope. Outside of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus and the power of that resurrection to usward who believe, every child of Adam would pass into oblivion, never to be remembered in the land of the living.

Sins are enmity toward God. So by His death Christ obtained forgiveness of sins so that He might remove that enmity. This we call reconciliation. This reconciliation was universal in that it was for every child of Adam. No one was barred. It is good news that we preach when we declare that the sins of the world have been forgiven. Today no one needs to seek for forgiveness. That has already been accomplished.

But the forgiveness of sins does not give one salvation. Rather, it reconciles the sinner to God so he can approach God to receive a new life which is freely given as a gift to such as will receive it.

So death is not the result of sins, but sin. The sin of rejection an keep one from receiving the sift of eternal life. This life sost the precious blood of Christ. This life is in Him. He that hath the Son hath life. The Son and life are inseparable. If a person has one, he must have the other. That is God's plan. Man can take it or leave it, but he cannot change the terms. God has made them.

Beware of the lie of Satan. He denies the fact that the blood of Christ obtained the forgiveness of all. He bars access to God. -WHAT NATION?-

"He will destroy those wicked men, and will let out His vineyard unto other husbandmen, which shall render Him the fruits in their secsons." "The kingdom of God shall be taken from you, and given to a NATION bringing forth the fruits thereof." Matt. 21:41,43.

Who are the OTHER HUSBANDMEN? What NATION is meant? Does this refer to the Gentiles? Many people think so.

But when we read the prophecies, can we find anything which would at all indicate a possibility of the Gentiles ever taking over the kingdom which had been promised to Israel and of the throne on which the Heir of David was to sit? We must also remember that closely connected with this kingdom is the covenant. Do the Gentiles have a part in either the old or new covenant? Our Lord was crucified as King of the Jews. That was His official title. The new covenant is for the house of Israel. See Jer. 31:33.

Now in verse 45 in Matt. 21 the chief priests and Pharisees perceived that the Lord spoke of them. They were the wicked husbandmen. Would it not be possible that others of the house of Israel could be the OTHER HUSBANDMEN who would be more faithful than they, and take their places?

In Isa. 66:7-14 we have a prophecy that out of Israel will be born a new nation. Will not this new nation take the place of the old and bring forth fruits?

The old nation failed because they broke the old covenant. Because of the transgressions, they were put under law. They never did become the peculiar treasure and the priestly nation that they were intended to be. Never can they attain to this position and service until they accept the new covenant and their Messiah.

So in order that the will of God may be accomplished among the nations, a new nation must be born from the old and a new covenant must take the place of the old one. When the new covenant is in effect, the law will be abolished. -APOSTLES AND PROPHETS-

Many folks have gotten into trouble by ignoring boundries or line fences. Failure to recognize the dispensational boundry at Acts 28:28 has caused much confusion.

An example of this is the popular idea of the APOSTLES AND PRO-PHETS in Eph. Most folks think that they are the prophets of the O T and the apostles of the Gospels and Acts. But are they?

In Acts 26:22 Paul declared that up to that time he had preached nothing except what was already given by the prophets and Moses. He could not be blamed for teaching any new doctrine at that time.

Contrary to the opinions of many our Lord did not come to teach new doctrines, but to fulfil the law and the prophets. His ministry only confirmed the Scriptures.

When Paul was before the chiefs of the Jews in Rome and spoke to them all day, as recorded in Acts 28:23, he was PERSUADING THEM CON-CERNING JESUS, BOTH OUT OF THE LAW OF MOSES, AND OUT OF THE PROPHETS.

The present administration of the MYSTERY is nowhere in evidence before Acts 28:28. Neither is the hope of the kingdom dispensation offered at any time after that point of division.

The question which has caused so much trouble is Eph. 2:20 which states that the present structure or outcalling is built upon THE FOUNDATION OF THE APOSTLES AND PRO-PHETS. Again in Eph. 3:5 it is stated that the MYSTERY OF CHRIST was not made known to the sons of men in other ages as it is now revealed unto HIS HOLY AFOSTIES AND EROPHETS. The word NOW indicates that these apostles and prophets exist at the time of Paul's writing these words.

Eph. 4:11 gives us the complete answer and clears up any difficulty J.IGHT. anyone might have. Here the apostles and prophets are given to the church by the uscended Christ. John seems to be in darkness, it is bewas the last of the O T prophets. The 12 apostles were chosen by the Lord when on earth. Faul was the first spostle chosen by the ascended Lord. I am not able to say how many apostles and prophets there were after Acts 23:28.

-DARKNESS-

NO MAN HATH SEEN GOD AT ANY TIME. THE ONLY BEGOTTEN SON, WHICH IS IN THE BOSOM OF THE FATHER, HE HATH DECLARED HIM. John 1:18.

The greatest part of this declaration was that the character of God was revealed. Moses desired to see the glory of Jehovah, but it was not granted. He was hid in the cleft of the rock and saw only the hinder parts as God passed by. The character of God was not displayed by His hinder parts. Today we seek THE KNOWLEDGE OF THE GLORY OF GOD IN THE FACE OF CHRIST.

Glory could not be revealed to a people who had broken their covenant and to whom law was added because of the transgressions. THEN SPAKE SOLOMON, THE LORD SAID HE WOULD DWELL IN THE THICK DARKNESS. 1 Kgs. 8:12. Clouds and darkness are round about Him (Psa. 97:2).

This glory could have been revealed to the whole nation, but they rejected the ONE WHO could reveal it to them. But to the remnant Peter said, BUT YE ARE A CHO-SEN GENERATION, A ROYAL PRIESTHOOD, AN HOLY NATION, A PECULIAR PEOPLE; THAT YE SHOULD SHOW FORTH THE PRAI-SES OF HIM WHO HATH CALLED YOU OUT OF DARKNESS INTO HIS MARBELLOUS LIGHT (L Pet. 2:9).

COD IS LIGHT; JED IN HIM IS NO DARKNESS AT ALL...BUT IF WE VALK IN THE LIGHT, AS HE IS IN THE LIGHT, WE HIVE FELLOWSHIP ONE WITH ANOTHER. 1 John 1:5,7.

Isaiah, in prophesying of Israel said, THE PEOPLE THAT WALKED IN D. RKNESS HAVE SEEN A GREAT LIGHT. Not only did the light come to Israel, but the Lord came as the light of the world. The Gentiles, who were not a people, have a part in the light. The apostle Paul exhorted the Gentile Christians at Ephesus to WALK AS CHILDREN OF
