-THE N T CHURCH-

There is no New Testament church. There never has been one. You hear the expression quite often. Many churches claim that they are N T churches, but the claims are entirely false.

If such a thing as a N T church were to exist today, it would be a great wonder and marvel in contrast with the present organizations we see on every side. It would not need to train its workers with such things as Sunday Schools, Bible schools or seminaries. There would be little discussion or difference of opinion on theological subjects, proper conduct of the Christian, or other problems that plague and divide Christendom today. Why?

Whenever the New Testament is in effect, then "they shall teach no more every man his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: for they shall all know Me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, sayeth the Lord:" See Jer. 31:34.

The N T church will be made up of Israelites. It will not be a Gentile church in any sense of the word. "Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, that I will make a NEW COVENANT with the house of ISRAEL, and with the house of JU-DAH. Jer. 31:31.

The above is not true of Israel today. They have to be taught before they can teach. Whenever the conditions of Jer, 31 come to pass, then Israel will begin the GREAT COMMISSION of Matt. 28:19. it would be answered? That is the commission of the N T church. Nations, or Gentiles will be the ones taught. They will be the only ones who will need the teaching.

To Paul was committed the gospel of the dispensation of the Mystery. Timothy was instructed to commit the gospel he had from Paul to faithful men who should be able to teach others also.

There is nothing in the Word to indicate that Gentiles will ever be a part of the N T church. They will always need to be taught. But they cannot rightly claim the prerogatives of Israel.

THE LORD'S PRAYER-

"Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do." Here is one of the great crises of history. Israel had just refused their King and the kingdom. It was the opportunity to become the leading nation of the world, and they failed to take it. But now the Lord prays that they be forgiven. This means that they will have a SECOND CHANCE.

The Acts of the Apostles has in it the gospel of the second chance. If Israel would only repent, there would come the restitution of all things. As the 12 were being prepared to preach this gospel of the kingdom just before the ascension, they asked if at that time the kingdom would be restored to Israel. The Lord did not give a direct answer, but under the power of the Spirit, Peter at Pentecost made it clear that all hinged upon the repentance of Israel and the receiving of the New Covenant.

This prayer made possible the Acts ministry of the 12. If Israel had been set aside at the death of the Lord, then there would have been no ministry for the 12. They would have had no message. So it is clear that if the prayer had not been uttered and answered, then the gospel of the dispensation of the Mystery would have begun at Pentecost instead of 30 or more years later as it did. But if the church began at Pentecost, then this prayer was not answered. Did the Lord pray, as we so often do, with no idea that

This prayer also made possible the ministry of Paul to the Jew first. It even made it possible for the Gentiles to become partakers of the hope of Israel during Acts. If the Olive tree had been cut down at Calvary, then there would have been nothing into which to graff the Gentile believers. See Rom. 11.

This prayer made possible the writing of 1st & 2nd Pet., 1st, 2nd, & 3rd John, James, Jude; also, 1st & 2nd Cor., 1st & 2nd Thess., Gal., Heb., and Rom. The Rev. could have been written regardless. Think these things over. Read the Word.

-PROPHECY TCDAY-

The present status in Palestine seems to have many guessing. The events do not seem to fit in with popular notions of prophecy.

The Jew has been the subject of persecution ever since the servitude in Egypt. It is suggested that they were confused with the hated Amalakites by the Egyptians and so the chain of persecutions started. The Egyptians tried to destroy the race. Balak sought to have them cursed. The Babylonian captivity, servitudes and desolations cut into the number. The pogrom of Haman almost succeeded. Antiochus had many thousands killed. The inquisition made off with many more. Finally Hitler planned to kill 11,000,000 of them but only got 6,000,000 slain.

The greatest of persecutions is yet to come. (Matt. 24) More than 3 of the 70 weeks of Dan. 9 are yet to come. We know some of what will happen during the last week, but what of the times before that?

The Jews are not important enough at the present time for a world dictator to take much notice of them or make a treaty with them. Neither is a great world ruler in control of Jerusalem.

But when that time does come, the Jews will be a Christian nation. They will be, for the most part, in Asia minor or what is called Turkey now. It is very likely they will be rooted out of the land they now occupy and will have to take refuge in Turkey. They will be as a nation born in a day, that is they will swiftly accept Christ as their Messiah. This colony of Jews is described in Rev. 2 and 3. Then many will become lukewarm and worldly. They will be deceived and will make an agreement with the great dictator. After 3 1/2 years he will break the treaty. Then will begin the greatest tribulation the Jew has ever seen. The remnant will flee to the wilderness and there preserved 31/2years. There they will pray the so-called present age. Its time of writing does not

Lord's prayer.

-THE REVELATION-

This book is distinctly Jewish. In it nothing can be found concerning the Dispensation of the Mystery or the church which is the Body of Christ. The events all will take place when the present program is completed and Israel is ready to say, "Blessed is He that cometh in the name of the Lord."

There are over 285 references to the O T in the Rev. It deals wholly with prophecy. That is why that the dispensation of the Mystery has no place in it. The Mystery was hid from ages and generations and was not made known till after Acts 28:28. Men look in vain today for signs of the times. It is not the time of the signs.

The Rev. was left out of the canon of sacred Scriptures by the council of Laodices in 363 A D because there had never been a church at Thyatyra. Four years later Epiphanius wrote in defense of the book stating that this was prophecy and that a church would be there some time in the future.

The Rev. was concerning things which must shortly come to pass. They were not to come to pass shortly after John wrote, but after the beginning of the Day of the Lord with which the whole book is concerned. It was about the things he saw in the day of the Lord, what they meant and what was to come.

It is too bad that so many have been taken in by the false teaching that the 7 letters represent periods of history of the present age. It is necessary to use history books and newspapers to interpret the Bible in such a manner. But it is capable of explaining and interpreting itself.

Some have tried to limit the Day of the Lord to certain boundries, but we must remember that the Rev. is about the Day of the Lord. That takes in quite a scope. Compare with Isa. 13:6.

The Rev. does not take the ministry of Acts into consideration, neither the have anything to do with the message.
