-SOME PARALELLS-

This is a very brief outline and does not represent the great amount of thot put on it. Please study on these.

- 1. Dan. 12:12. Many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake. But there are 2 classes. Some will awake to everlasting life. Others to everlasting contempt and shame. These 2 classes constitute the MANY. What of the rest? Are not the MANY saved?
- 2. John 5:28,29. All that are in the graves shall hear His voice. Does this include all that sleep in the dust? Or does it refer to the MANY? Again there are 2 classes. There is a resurrection of life and a resurrection of judgment. All are believers for they are judged by their works. Otherwise John 3:16 would be nullified. Only His sheep hear His voice. ALL then is limited.
- 3. Acts 24:15. This is a resurrection of the dead. There are 2 classes. The just and the unjust are there. Unjust does not always mean unjustified. It may be those who have acted unjustly, as the unjust steward.
- 4. 1 Cor. 3:11-15. The setting is THE DAY. There are 2 classes. Some receive rewards. Some are saved as by fire, no reward. All have built on the right foundation. All are saved. There is shame and contempt and judgment for those whose works do not abide.
- 5. kev. 20:12, 13. This is a judgment of the REST of the dead. It is on the basis of works as is always with believersbut ruin in a short time and it is to the These cannot be wicked folks for the ungodly shall not rise in the judgment nor can those who believe not the Son ever see life. The time is the same as in Job 14:12. It is when the heavens pass away. The RV of Rev. 20:15 reads, "And IF any was not found written in the book of life, he was cast into the lake of fire." This shows the unlikelyhood of any unbelievers being present. It is quite likely that both Job and the dying malefactor will be there. This must be the time of resurrection of all who have everlasting life according to the gospel of John.

## -WHAT CHURCH?-

Somebody has asked the question, "What church is Christ building?" This is a strange question, for as I have been looking into the Word, I cannot find that Christ is building any church today.

Many people point to Matt. 16:18 and then take it for granted that there is the only church that has ever existed. No one can ever build a doctrine on the word CHURCH. It can and does mean anything from a mob to an assembly of saints. It might be well to take the concordance and see how it is used in the Scriptures.

"...and upon this rock (i.e. upon "Christ...the Son of the living God"according to Peter's confession) I will build My church." Matt. 16:18. (Notice, Christ said 'I will build... Does this include the church in the wilderness? Does it include the church which God is building today with Christ as the Head?

Heb. 3:6 - "But Christ as a Son over His own house, which house are WE." This refers to the same group as in Acts 2:47 where the word CHURCH does not appear in the original -- "And the Lord added to them day by day those that were being saved. "(RV) As we note the various Churches mentioned, especially during the Acts period, we are struck with the fact that they are churches here on earth. Even for a short time after the revelation of the dispensation of the Mystery corporate witnesses are still on the earth, See 1 Tim. and Titus. But there is nothing individual that the later prison epistles are addressed.

Eph. 1:22, 23 says, "And He (The Father) hath put all things under His (Christ's) feet, and gave Him to be Head over all things to the Church, which is His body." Here is the church that is being built. God is building it.

The Mystery which had been hid from ages and generations gives us the key to heaven. Never before had any church or assembly a hope of going to heaven. This is very significant and shows that Acts 28:28 is the dividing line.

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## -GALATIANS-

If you would like to get the setting for this epistle, read the 13th & 14th chaps, of Acts to get the message that was preached to the churches of Galatia. Then read Acts 15 where the council at Jerusalem took up the question that was plaguing the Galatians. Note the decision.

After Paul had preached his gospel of grace to the Gentiles in all this region, certain of the Jews came in and taught that the Gentiles must be circumcised to be saved. Certain Pharisees that believed at Jerusalem backed this up. So the whole argument in Galatians revolves around the question of circumcision.

It may be that you do not see why this should be the question. Here is the reason. The Jews wanted the Gentiles to observe the law with its feasts and titualistic practices. But according to the law this could not be done without the rite of circumcision. V. e must remember that these Gentiles could not observe the Lord's supper or any of the other feasts of Lev. 23 unless they were first circumcised. Of course the Gentiles did not want to be left out of the circle in these things and so they leaned very much toward doing what the Jews demanded.

That is why Paul called them "foolish" in 3:1. Paul declared that his gospel of grace was not taught him by man, but came by revelation from God. He also stated plainly that the Judaizers merely wished to glory in their flesh.

During Acts the Gentiles were baptized with water which showed that they were identified with repentant Israel. But baptism was not a part of the law, being introduced by John. The law that the uncircumcised could not partake of the Lord's supper was never abrogated. As you read the last chapter of Gal. you will be reminded that we still have some of those Pharisees who would glory in your flesh if they could.

Do not confuse the calling of these Galatians with that of the dispensation of the Mystery.

-WHAT IS... THE MYSTERY? -

In the Scriptures a mystery is something that is kept a secret till the time comes to reveal it. There are many of them and each has its time and place.

\* \* \* \* \* \* \*

But now we are interested in the secret given as a special revelation to Paul to be given in turn to Gentiles. It was a secret that was hidden from ages and generations in God till it was revealed to Paul.

Then this secret could not be the grafting in of the Gentiles during the latter part of the Acts. For it had been promised to Abraham that thru or by means of his seed all nations should be blest. It was not secret that the Gentile nations should come to the fore and Israel be set aside. It was not secret that Gentiles would be used of God in an attempt to provoke Israel to jealousy. All these things had been foretold.

But it had not been revealed that at some time God would deal with the Gentiles direct instead of thru Israel. It had not been known that Gentiles would ever have all blessings in Christ instead of thru the promise to Abraham. It also was never revealed that at some time Jews and Gentiles would have a heavenly calling instead of an earthly one. It was not known that a body or group of people would be manifested in glory with Christ in the heavenlies. All these things were absolutely unknown till the end of the Acts and the setting aside of Israel.

So the secret was that Jew and Gentile would have a dispensational equality, that blessings would be in the heavenlies in Christ instead of thru Abraham, and that the c alling would be a heavenly one instead of earthly. These were the things that God revealed to Paul after Acts 28: 28 with the instructions to make them known to all men. No longer was the Jew to be first. No longer did the Jew have the priority in making known the gospel. No longer did they look for the return of the Lord in the air. A new calling and hope had come into view. Do you have a part in them?
