-JUDGMENT OF THE NATIONS-

This is mentioned and pictured many times in the Word. But let us look at the record as we find it in Matt. 25:31-46. By the use of marginal references and a concordance, you may be able to find a great many other references to it.

The first thing we note is the TIME. It is at the coming of the Lord when He has set up His throne. He will rule, first of all, over His people Israel having received the throne from His father David. But this rule will be extended over all the nations of the world.

So when we look for those who will be affected, we find that it is all the nations of the earth. That answers the question WHO. Notice, no resurrection is in view. Only the nations who are living when He comes appear in the scene. This is a thousand years too early for the resurrection of those from among the nations who have received the gift of everlasting life.

This judgment is a SEPARATION. The sheep nations are distinct from the goat nations. Sheep can be led. They can accept the will of another. Goats are wilful. They have a will of their own.

The BASIS of the judgment is not according to their faith. There is no mention of Christ and His redemptive work. They do not even know Christ. Those who do well are not even aware of what they have done. They ask how they have done well. Those who do not well also do not know wherein they have failed. They also ask about it. They are simply judged on the basis of what they have or have not done.

The penalty for the goat nations is
EVERLASTING PUNISHMENT. We do
hear a great deal about this, but it so
happens that this is the only place in all
the Word that the expression occurs.
Note again that this has nothing to do with
any people raised from the dead. In verse
41 this punishment is explained. It is to
be cast into the lake of fire prepared for
other beings than mankind. It is called
elsewhere THE SECOND DEATH. But it
is the first and the last death that these
will die.

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The reward for the sheep nations is LIFE ETERNAL. And that on the basis of doing deeds of charity - not forgetting the Jew! Now if everlasting punishment is for all sinners, how about this life?

-STUDIES IN EPHESIANS- #4

Another phrase that meets the eye in 1:3 is IN CHRIST. This is one of the key notes in the epistle. In Eph. we find what we are in Christ. In Phil, we find what we are to do with Christ in us; to work out our salvation with fear and trembling.

In this first occurance we find that all the spiritual blessings in the heavenlies are IN CHRIST. As we read on down thru the doctrinal section, the first 3 chapters, we find that we are chosen IN HIM (1:4), accepted IN THE BELOVED (1:6), IN WHOM...redemption (1:7), in the fulness of times all things gathered together IN CHRIST (1:10), IN WHOM we have obtained an inheritance (1:11), that those who trust IN CHRIST shall be to the praise of His glory (1:12), IN WHOM the Ephesians also trusted (1:13), IN WHOM they were also sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise (1:13), and Paul was thankful to hear of their faith IN THE LORD JESUS,

Then there is that great resurrection power wrought IN CHRIST(1:20) which reaches out and has made us to sit in the heavenlies IN CHRIST (2:6), created IN CHRIST JESUS unto good works which were before ordained that we should walk in them (2:10), IN CHRIST JESUS we who once were far off are made nigh (2:13), IN WHOM all the holy temple (the Body) grows (2:21), and IN WHOM we are builded together for an habitation of God.

We hear about joint-heirs, in a joint-body, and joint-partakers of His promise IN CHRIST (3:6), that the eternal purpose of the Father is IN CHRIST JESUS (3:11), IN WHOM we have boldness and access.

Take your Bible and go over these slowly and think on them. It is a very profitable study. These facts help us to see more fully the mystery of Christ which in other ages and generations was not so fully revealed and known as it is now. Let us thank the Father for such a wonderful revelation.

These facts remind us that the Lord once said that He was the true and living way, that no one came to the Father but by Him. When we humbly contemplate the above expressions, we can see that all we can ever have must be in HIM. The Father has planned it that way that He and the Son might both be glorified.

All this calls for praise to Him who in infinite wisdom has included us poor Gentiles in His eternal purpose.

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-THE SUPREME PENALTY-

Many of you do not have access to any libraries of much size. You might be interested in what some of the earlier writers believed. Such a study will show the beginnings and spread of apostacy and the creeping in of heathen philosophies into the churches.

In THE DURATION AND NATURE OF FUTURE PUNISHMENT by Henry Constable (1868), we find a little table of the early writers and their views on this subject. The death date of each is given.

Barnabas (90), Clement of Rome (100), Hermas (104), Ignatius, Martyr (107), Polycarp, Martyr (147), Justin, Martyr (164), and Theophilus, of Antioch (183), all held to the Scriptural view that the supreme penalty for all who did not have life was eternal death.

Then came in a couple of minor writers, Athenagoras (190) and Tatian (200), who were steeped in the Greek philosophies of Plato and Aristotle. The Greeks got their ideas from Babylon. So these two advanced the idea of the immortality of the soul ("Thou shalt not surely die," the lie of Satan). Their writings were not taken so seriously and they were considered more or less as heretics.

Two more writers, true to the Word, came in about this place. They were Irenaeus, Martyr (202) and Clement Alexandrinus (212).

Then the Greek influence again was felt. Tertullian (235) not only came out with the theory of the immortality of the soul, but he also taught the idea of the eternal conscious torment of the lost. This idea came especially from the Greek myths, which they themselves did not believe. They were stories to entertain. Hippolytus (204) followed with the same teaching.

This was so revolting to Origen (235) that he invented the idea of universal restoration of all. He also put forth the idea that our Lord was a created being, not deity. He fell into the error of universal restoration because he accepted the theory of the immortality of the soul. Something had to be done with this soul.

Arnobius (303) still held to the teaching of the Scriptures, but when Augustine (430) came on the scene, both the false teachings, the immortality of the soul and eternal conscious torment, were then fastened on the church to stay.

-A PROPHETIC PARABLE-

Take your Bible and read Matt. 22:1-14. We do not have space to go into any detail, but we can get a rough outline from which to work.

1. Servants go out to CALL them that are bidden to the feast. They would not come! This is a picture of the proclamation of the kingdom from John the Baptist to Calvary. The rejection was complete by the time of Matt. 12 which is followed by a revelation of the secrets of the kingdom in chapter 13. The final outcome is the murder of the Prince of Peace.

2. Other servants go forth. The message is still to those who have been bidden. It is the marriage banquet of the Lamb and the bidden quests are Israel.

The servants here are the apostles in their ministry of the times of Acts. All things are ready. The great sacrifice has been made. The sufferings of the Messiah have been completed. He is in the heavens waiting to come. But the people have no room in their lives for the offer. They go about their OWN business. No time for the Messiah!

But some of those wicked people take the servants and mistreat them and kill them. Is not that what happened to the apostles?

The outcome: those murderers were destroyed and their city burned. This was done by a Roman general, Titus, in A.D. 70. (Read the description by Josephus)

This second offer to them that were bidden was made possible by the prayer on Calvary, "Forgive them."

Now there is a gap of a couple of thousand years between verses 7 and 8. That gap is the present parenthesis in which is proclaimed the gospel of everlasting life and the dispensation of the mystery.

3. Go into the highways. This is a future ingathering of Israel from the four corners of the earth. They are scattered far and wide. The wedding will be furnished with guests some day!

In this part of the story is the appearance of the man without the proper wedding garment. The garment is the sign of election. God will gather His elect.

You may go on with the study, but the point we wanted to get was an offer of the kingdom, then a re-offer which ended with the pronouncement of Acts 28:28. No servants are authorized today to gather in those that were bidden.

DEAR YOUNG FOLKS: A few days ago
I was reading again of the passage of the
Red Sea in Exodus 14. What a great drama
that was! Few realize what a great thing
was done there, a stupendous miracle!

There is hardly a body of water in the world where the heat gets more intense than at the Red Sea. The region round about is practically a desert. If a sailing boat gets becalmed on the sea, the sailors will lie on the decks panting for breath in

the stifling heat.

Now for our picture. A frigid east wind blew that night. The waters parted and froze! The deep ooze of the bottom also froze. So the Israelites were able to go across dry shod. They did not even get their feet muddy. They say that there is much muck and ooze in the bottom at this point.

Here, up to 3 million people went across, as well as all their flocks and herds. Behind them was a great wall of fire which made it almost as light as day. They could plainly see where they were going. They could keep an eye on each other, their baggage, and their little ones, as well as the animals.

But the Egyptians were behind this cloud of fire and to them it was black. They could not see. But they knew what was going on. They thot that if these runaway slaves could cross, then they could do the same.

Pharaoh was leading the army in person. It was a great one, with thousands of chariots and horses.

But by the time the Egyptians were getting into the midst of the sea, the frost began to go out of the ground. The result was disasterous to them. The horses began to break thru the frozen crust. Also the chariot wheels would break thru, and when the chariots were turned to one side or the other, the wheels would break off. Soon there was great confusion in the darkness. Men and horses and chariots were hopelessly mixed up in the muck and mire. Then the walls of water gave way, the ice breaking, and the whole army was overwhelmed in the sea. None was able to escape.

Oh yes, How did I know that it was frozen? Well, in Ex. 15:8 it says that the waters were congealed. So far as I know, that would be ice!
